



## Butterfly Cycle Mobile

Butterfly Cycle Mobile can be used to display the life cycle of the butterfly. Use twine, yarn or string to fasten two sticks together in an "X" shape. Hang the butterfly cycle from the sticks using string or thread. Decorate if desired.

### Materials:

- colored paper, crayons or markers
- ruler, scissors, white paste, stapler, tape

- yarn or string
- piece of cardboard or strong card
- 2 twigs, metal rods or sticks

### Directions:

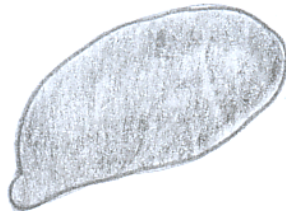
1. Draw a leaf using green paper. Draw some small white circles. (The white circles are the butterfly eggs.)



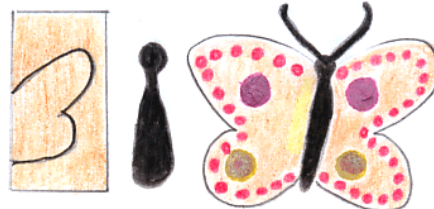
2. Draw and cut out a caterpillar. (The egg hatches into a caterpillar.)



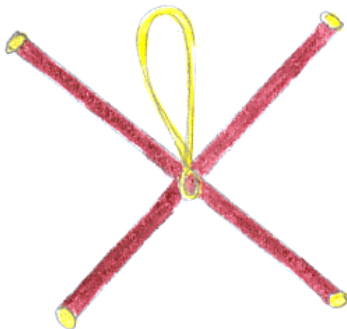
3. Draw and cut out a pupa. (The caterpillar turns into a pupa.)



4. Make butterfly wings by folding a piece of paper in half; draw half a butterfly on the folded line; cut out. Use dark paper for the body; paste body to wings; decorate.



5. Cross 2 twigs; join together with piece of string/twine.



6. Staple or tape leaf, caterpillar, pupa and butterfly to string and attach to "X" shape. Attach piece of string to center of "X" shape; hang up the mobile.
