

Coconut Mobile

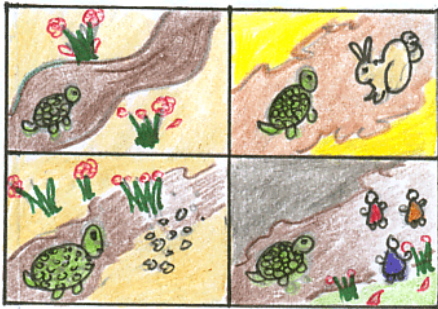
Coconut Mobile can be used to display scenes from a story, steps to a problem, life cycle, water cycle or a variety of other concepts. Use twine, yarn or string to fasten two sticks together in an "X" shape. Hang the coconuts from the sticks using string or thread. Hang completed mobile.

Materials:

- crayons or markers, scissors
- grass, flowers, pebbles, sand, seeds
- yarn, string, or twine
- poster board, card or chart paper
- straight stick sticks
- coconuts

Directions:

1. Draw 4 scenes from the story.



2. Cut a square about 5 cm x 3cm in the side of each coconut. Cut a small hole in the top of each coconut.



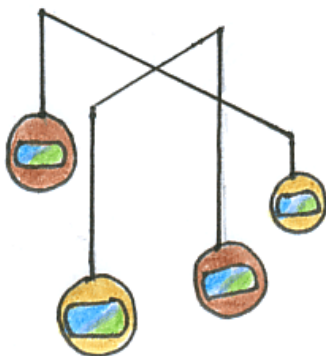
3. Cut pieces of string of different lengths: 10 cm, 16 cm, 20 cm, 24 cm, 30 cm. Insert a string into top of each coconut and tie.



4. Create one scene in each coconut using grass, flowers, pebbles and small pictures. Make label for each coconut and paste.



5. Tie the coconuts to the X-shape.



6. Attach another piece of short string to the stick. Hang-up mobile.
