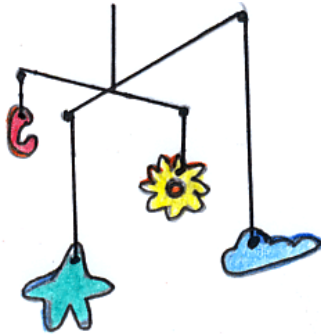


Dough Mobile

Dough Mobile can be used to display characters from a story, Math Shapes, life cycles or a variety of other concepts. Use twine, yarn or string to fasten two sticks together in an "X" shape. Hang the dough shapes from the sticks using twine or thread. Hang completed mobile.



Materials:

- 125 mL cornstarch, 250 mL baking soda, 175 mL water
- pot, spoon, bowl, damp cloth, wax paper
- cookie cutter or knife
- acrylic paints
- two sticks in X shape; twine or string

Directions:

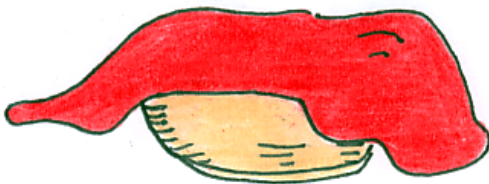
1. In a pot, mix together 125 mL cornstarch and 250 mL baking soda. Add 175 mL water. Stir until smooth.



2. Cook mixture over medium heat stirring constantly. When mixture is smooth and thick, remove from the heat.



3. Spoon ball of clay into bowl. Cover bowl with damp cloth.



4. When clay is cool, knead it on a surface dusted with cornstarch.



5. Roll out clay on waxed paper. Use cookie cutters or knife to cut out shapes. Use straw to poke hole in the center top of each shape. Let shapes dry for 2 days.



6. Paint with acrylic paint. Thread string through each hole. Attach shapes to X shape with the string. Hang-up mobile.
